“EXTENDING GOD’S GRACE TO UN-EXPECTING PEOPLE”
(II Samuel 9:1-13)

Today’s Thesis: In order to passionately pursue God’s agenda, we must learn to extend God’s grace to un-expecting people. Today’s question: What do I need to understand about God’s grace in order to reach un-expecting people?

I. God’s grace always takes the **INITIATIVE** in your life.

II. God’s grace is extended to us not for our sakes, but for the sake of **JESUS CHRIST**.

III. God’s grace has the **POWER** to cover our brokenness when we respond to Him by faith.

- A. He **BELIEVED** the message. (II Samuel 9:6a; Ephesians 2:8-9)
- B. He **HUMBLED** himself. (II Samuel 9:8; Ephesians 2:1)
- C. He was **ACCEPTED**. (II Samuel 9:7; Ephesians 2:4)
- D. He was made an **HEIR**. (II Samuel 9 :7)
- E. He w as **ADOPTED**. (II Samuel 9 :11b; Romans 8:14; Revelation 19:9)
