“WHO HAS YOUR BACK?” - (Isaiah 58:8)

Introduction: The word “*rereward*” appears only {SIX} times in the Bible! It refers to “the rear guard of an army.” It also means “to come after or behind!” The text says, “{GOD} wants to have your back!” The tribe of {DAN} was given this responsibility in Israel (Numbers 10:25)!

I. Has God got your back on your PAST?
