“REPENTANCE”

Introduction: Our subject is applicable to **{ALL PEOPLE}** (Acts 17:30). Even **{BELIEVERS}** need to repent (Revelation 2:5). Only **{GOD}** never needs to repent (Numbers 23:19). Biblical repentance is something which must be **{PREACHED TO ALL}** (Luke 24:46-47).

I. REPENTANCE MEANS {TO CHANGE YOUR MIND}

*Acts 3:19-20 *II Corinthians 7:8-11 *Matthew 27:3 *Philippians 3:5-9 *Matthew 21:28-31a

Note: There are two kinds of **{SORROW}**: *Godly Sorrow and Worldly Sorrow*

II. REPENTANCE INCLUDES MORE THAN {ACTIONS}.

*Acts 2:36-38 *Job 42:6 *Acts 10:34-35 *Acts 19:1-5 *Acts 20:21

Note: Repentance without **{FAITH}** does not save.

III. REPENTANCE SHOULD BE DONE {QUICKLY}

*Revelation 3:19 *Hebrews 12:16-17 *II Timothy 2:24-26 *II Peter 3:9b-10a

Note: Repentance is **{PERSONAL}**! No one else can do it for you!

Conclusion: God is very **{GRACIOUS AND MERCIFUL}** toward those who truly repent. (Luke 15:7; Psalm 51:17; & Matthew 5:4)
