

Sermon Notes
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“THE TEMPTATIONS OF JESUS”

Introduction: From the {FIRST} book in the Bible to the {LAST} book, the Bible tells about the Devil. His {NAMES} tell us much about his activities! One of these is {TEMPER} (Matthew 4:3). Jesus showed us how to deal with {TEMPTATION}. (Luke 4:1-14)

I. THE DEVIL TEMPTS {SAVED & SPIRITUAL} PEOPLE

*Luke 4:1-2 *Luke 22:31 *I Thessalonians 2:18 *Job 2:3
*Zechariah 3:1 *Revelation 12:9-10

Note: Satan attack Jesus when He was: {ALONE}; {HUNGRY}; and {TIRED}.

II. THE DEVIL IS THE {SOURCE} OF ALL TEMPTATION

*Luke 4:2-6 *James 1:13-15

Note: Temptation is {NOT} sin nor lack of spirituality. (Hebrews 4:15)

III. THE DEVIL MUST BE {RESISTED} WHEN TEMPTED

*Luke 4:8-12 *James 4:7b-8a *Luke 22:45-46 *Ephesians 6:17b

Note: It is necessary to resist the devil {REPEATEDLY}. (I Peter 5:8-9)

IV. WHEN THE DEVIL IS DEFEATED, HE WILL {RETURN}

*Luke 4:13 *Matthew 12:43-45 *II Corinthians 10:3-4

Note: It is SO important we fill our lives with {SPIRITUAL GOOD}!

Conclusion: After resisting temptations and the devil, there will be new spiritual {POWER}! (Luke 4:14)
