(Galatians 4:4-5)

I. THE PROMISES OF GOD ARE {INFALLIBLE}

*Matthew 1:18-23 *Isaiah 7:14 *Matthew 2:1-6 *Matthew 2:15
*Matthew 2:17 *Matthew 2:23 *Matthew 5:18
*Matthew 24:35 *Titus 1:2 *Psalm 119:49-50

Application: This gives us {CONFIDENCE} in all the other promises of God!

II. THE PROMISES OF GOD REQUIRE {PATIENCE}

*Galatians 4:4-5 *Luke 2:25-30 *Hebrews 10:35-38 *Habakkuk 2:3
*Psalm 27:13-14 *Romans 12:12 *Proverbs 10:28 *Proverbs 13:12

Application: This gives us {HOPE} while we are waiting upon God!

III. THE PROMISES OF GOD ARE {SUPER - NATURAL}

*Luke 1:26-38 *Genesis 3:15 *Galatians 4:4-7
*Ephesians 3:20-21 *Jeremiah 33:3 *John 1:12

Conclusion: There is another {PROMISE} God has given us in His Word. This same {JESUS} will come again (John 14:2-3). **GOD ALWAYS KEEPS HIS PROMISES!**
