

## "PRAYING AS JESUS PRAYED"

### "Lord, Teach Us To Pray" - Lesson Four (Luke 22:39-45)

**Introduction:** The Bible tells believers to "*follow the {steps} of Jesus*" (1 Peter 2:21). In our study on prayer, we have learned from His teachings (Luke 11:1). Today, we will study the {prayer} life of Jesus.

#### I. DID JESUS HAVE A {PLACE} TO PRAY?

\*Luke 22:39-40   \*Mark 1:35   \*Mark 6:46   \*Matthew 6:5-6  
\*Luke 5:15-16   \*Luke 6:12-13   \*John 18:1-2   \*Acts 3:1   \*Acts 10:9

**Note:** The early church had set {times} to pray.

#### II. WHAT {POSTURE} DID JESUS USE TO PRAY?

\*Luke 22:41   \*Matthew 26:29   \*Luke 22:45   \*Luke 9:28-33   \*John 17:1  
\*Daniel 6:10

**Note:** The most frequent posture in Scripture is {kneeling}.

#### III. WHAT {PERSON} OF GOD DID JESUS USE IN PRAYER?

\*Luke 22:41-42   \*Luke 23:33-34   \*Matthew 6:7-9   \*John 14:13-14   \*Romans 8:26-27

**Note:** A believer should approach God as a {Father}; our access is the {Son}, and our encourager is the {Holy Spirit}.

#### IV. DID JESUS HAVE A {POSITIVE} ATTITUDE IN PRAYER?

\*Luke 22:43-44   \*Mark 6:38-44   \*John 11:41-44   \*Matthew 6:6  
\*Isaiah 37:10-12a   \*Isaiah 37:14-17   \*Isaiah 37:20-22a   \*Isaiah 37:33-36

**Conclusion:** Jesus knew that "*nothing lies beyond the power of prayer, except that which is outside the {will} of God!*" (1 John 2:6)
