Context: “A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came unto him, after he had gone in to Bath-sheba.” (*II Samuel 11:1-5 / 15 / 27*)

I. A CHRISTIAN CAN {SIN}!

Note: Sins of omission always precede sins of commission.

II. WHEN A CHRISTIAN SINS, THERE WILL BE {CONSEQUENCES}!

**Psalm 51:3 *John 16:8 *Psalm 51:11 *Psalm 22:1-3a*

**I John 1:6-7 *Psalm 51:12 *Galatians 5:22 *Hebrews 12:6*

1. A guilty conscience.

2. A separation from God.

Note: Sin does not break a Christian’s relationship with God, but it does break our fellowship with God.

3. A loss of joy.

III. WHEN A CHRISTIAN REPENTS, THEY WILL RECEIVE {GOD’S MERCY & GRACE}!
