

"WHY HAS GOD FORSAKEN ME?"

(Messages from the Cross Series – Part Three)

Note: One of the <u>seven</u> times Jesus spoke from the cross, it was a direct <u>quote</u> from the Old Testament! (Psalm 22:1) One thousand years later, at <u>3:00</u> on the cross, Jesus quoted this Psalm. (Mark 15:33-34) What is the meaning?

I. IT DECLARES THE {HOLINESS} OF GOD.

Note: The most prominent attribute of God is His holiness.

Note: The precise time Jesus became a sacrifice for sin, God caused darkness!

II. IT DECLARES THE CONSEQUENCES OF {SIN}.

Note: The greatest consequence of sin is spiritual!

III. IT DECLARES THE GREAT {LOVE OF GOD}.

Note: Jesus was separated from God, so sinners could be reconciled with God!
