Note: The Gospel of John was written to unbelievers (John 20:30-31). The Epistles of John were written to believers (I John 5:11-13).

BELIEVERS WILL (SIN) AFTER THEY ARE SAVED. I.

Note: Sin in a believer breaks fellowship with God, not relationship.
