(Doctrine of Salvation Series – Part Three)

Note: The Gospel of John was written to unbelievers (*John 20:30-31*). The Epistles of John were written to believers (*I John 5:11-13*).

I. BELIEVERS WILL {SIN} AFTER THEY ARE SAVED.

Note: Sin in a believer breaks fellowship with God, not relationship.

II. JESUS' {INTERCESSION} IN HEAVEN MAINTAINS A BELIEVER'S RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD ON EARTH!

Note: It is God's will that all believers be holy.

Note: Believers at all stages of maturity are saved.
