

## “THREE MEN WHO WOULD NOT BOW, BUDGE, NOR BURN”

(God’s Hall of Faith Series – Sixteen – Hebrews 11:34)

Introduction: Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were contemporaries of Daniel. They were Jews taken into Babylonian Captivity in sixth century B.C.

### I. THEY SERVED UNDER AN {UNGODLY} KING.

*\*Daniel 2:48-49*

*\*Daniel 3:1-2*

*\*1 Timothy 2:1-2*

Note: Believers are to honor and pray for those in authority.

### II. THEY FACED AN {UNSCRIPTURAL} LAW.

*\*Daniel 3:4-7*

*\*Exodus 20:4-5*

*\*Daniel 3:8-12*

*\*Acts 5:29*

Note: If human law contradicts God’s law, believers are to obey God.

### III. THEY ENCOUNTERED AN {UNCHANGABLE} SENTENCE.

*\*Daniel 3:13-15*

*\*Daniel 6:15*

*\*John 15:20*

Note: Do not be surprised when your obedience of God brings persecution.

### IV. THEY POSSESSED AN {UNCOMPROMISING} FAITH.

*\*Daniel 3:16-18*

*\*Philippians 2:15*

*\*Job 1:9-11*

Note: They believed God could save them and that God would save them, but they had an “if not” clause in their faith!

### V. THEY SAW AN {UNFAILING} SAVIOR.

*\*Daniel 3:19-25*

*\*Daniel 3:26-27*

*\*Hebrews 11:34a*

Conclusion: This was a rare Christophany! This was Jesus!
