"TWO WOMEN! TWO PROPHETS! ONE GOD!"

(God's Hall of Faith Series – Eighteen – Hebrews 11:35a)

<u>Introduction</u>: Two identical <u>miracles</u> happened to two unnamed <u>women</u>. God placed them in His <u>Hall of Faith!</u> (*I Corinthians 10:11 / Romans 10:17*)

- I. A {WIDOW} OF ZAREPHATH & ELIJAH. (I Kings 17:7-9)
- 1. She was a widow. (I Kings 17:10 / Psalm 68:5)
- 2. She was a generous woman. (I Kings 17:11-13)

Note: It takes great faith to give away your last meal in a famine! (Luke 6:38a)

- 3. She was a <u>blessed</u> woman. (I Kings 17:14-16 / Acts 20:35b)
- 4. She became a broken-hearted woman. (I Kings 17:17-18)
- 5. She obtained a Hall of Faith miracle. (I Kings 17:19-24 / James 5:17a)
- II. A {SHUNAMMITE} WOMAN & ELISHA.
- 1. She was a very wealthy woman. (II Kings 4:8a)
- 2. She was a hospitable woman. (II Kings 4:8b)
- 3. She was a spiritual woman. (II Kings 4:9)
- 4. She was a generous woman. (II Kings 4:10)
- 5. She was a contented woman. (II Kings 4:11-13 / Philippians 4:11)
- 6. She was a barren woman. (II Kings 4:14-16)
- 7. She was a blessed woman. (II Kings 4:17 / Psalm 127:3)
- 8. She was a woman of great <u>faith</u>. (II Kings 4:18-26 / Mark 11:22-23)

Note: There are different levels of faith. (Matthew 8:26 / Matthew 15:28)

9. She was a determined woman. (II Kings 4:27-37)

<u>Conclusion</u>: <u>Elijah</u> and <u>Elisha</u> were men of God and men of faith. But God focuses on two unnamed women's faith.
