I. IT IS NOT UNSPIRITUAL TO BE {RICH}!

Note: A person’s spiritual condition is not determined by financial status.

II. IT IS NOT UNSPIRITUAL TO {SAVE MONEY}!

**Proverbs 21:20* **Proverbs 6:6-8* **Luke 12:16-17* **I Timothy 6:17-18*
**Luke 12:18-19* **Luke 12:20*

Note: The Bible says, “it is foolish not to have a will”!

III. IT IS WRONG TO PUT MONEY AHEAD OF {GOD}!

**Luke 12:20-21* **Mark 10:17-23* **Matthew 6:19-21*
**Philippians 4:11-12* **Matthew 6:33*

Note: This parable is a warning about the deceitfulness of money.

IV. IT IS {FOOLISH} FOR ANY PERSON NOT TO PREPARE TO DIE AND FACE GOD!

**Luke 12:20* **Matthew 16:26* **Luke 19:1-6*
**Luke 19:8-9a* **Hebrews 13:5*

Note: A Spirit-filled believer will be content regardless of financial status.
