A person must {give} to be blessed (Luke 6:38).

A wise plan of stewardship is the {10/10/80} budget (I Corinthians 4:2).

I. GOD IS {MERCIFUL}.

II. GOD IS {POWERFUL}.

Note: Jesus did not reverse the {miracle}! He does not reverse our salvation.
