<u>Facts</u>: All four Gospels tell about John the Baptist and the <u>baptism</u> of Jesus! Three Gospels tell about Jesus' t<u>emptations</u>. Two Gospels declare His virgin birth. There are <u>five</u> events that only Luke reveals!

<u>Note</u>	At twelve years old, Jesus knew who was His Father.
